(@ 250 So. Vernal Ave, Central Education Center, look for mailbox just inside front entry)

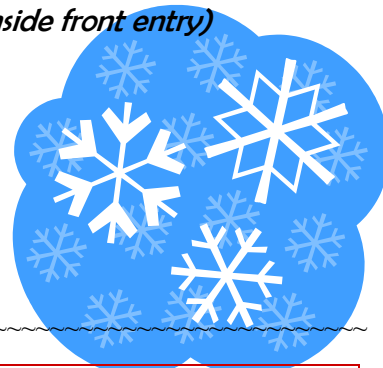
**Prizes will be awarded in all three age groups—**
